SUPPORTING TRANSGENDER & GENDER EXPANSIVE YOUTH IN EDUCATION SETTINGS

During this workshop, participants will increase their knowledge and competency when working with transgender students. Presenter will focus on language, terminology, and factors influencing an individuals' awareness of gender identity. Presenter will highlight current research studies regarding mental health outcomes for LGBTQ students. Based on these outcomes, participants will learn more regarding best practice guidelines for providing affirming care and support to transgender youth.

Samantha King, MSW, M.Ed. is the education coordinator and an intake specialist at the Gender and Sexuality Development Clinic. Samantha coordinates new family intake and manages the educational materials for the clinic. Through this role, she provides direct resources to families and supports transgender and gender-expansive youth in school and community settings. Samantha collaborates with providers to raise their awareness of gender identity and works to improve gender inclusivity through training and policy support.
